Riders confirmation starts at 7:30 and ends 45 minutes before the start of category in which rider is competing. Team managers must confirm all riders

TRACK

5 sections, 3 rounds on artificial obstacles (rocks, logs, concrete, tires, pallets), ~350 m length, sections may be ridden in any order.



PROMESA (5–8 y.o.) – purple arrows BOYS U10 (9-10 y.o.) - white arrows BOYS U12 (11–12 y.o.) – blue arrows BOYS U14 (13–14 y.o.) – green arrows BOYS U16 (15–16 y.o.) – black arrows GIRLS U10 (9-10 y.o.) - white arrows GIRLS U13 (11–13 y.o.) – white/blue mix GIRLS U16 (14-16 y.o.) - green arrows MEN JUNIOR 20, 26 (16 - 18 y.o.) - red arrows **OPEN PURPLE** – purple arrows **OPEN WHITE – white arrows OPEN BLUE – blue arrows OPEN GREEN** – green arrows **OPEN BLACK - black arrows** MEN ELITE 20, 26 (19+ y.o.) - yellow arrows WOMEN ELITE (19+ y.o.) – pink arrows WOMEN JUNIOR (16-18 y.o.) - orange arrows

LICENSES

To be officially classified in the European Youth Games or the Polish Championship, a valid UCI license is required. Participation without a license is allowed, but a legal guardian must sign the start list to confirm that the rider is participating at their own risk.









SCORING

According to UCI rules. Trophies for the top 3 riders in each category. Licensed riders earn points toward the annual series.

Polish Championship titles will be awarded to male and female riders holding a valid UCI license and Polish nationality, in categories compliant with UCI regulations. A minimum of three competitors in a given category is required for the title to be awarded.

ENTRY FEE

It is possible to start in the second category after finishing the race in the first chosen category.
